Buying Options:

- **PURCHASE AN ANIMAL** – Supporters have the ability to purchase any animal in the sale. Please obtain a buyers number prior to the sale. Buyer pays full bid price and receives the animal. Animals may be taken home or sent to the processing facility. When checking out, please inform the clerk which processing facility will be used if the animal is designated for harvest.
- **SPLIT AN ANIMAL** – This option allows for the joint purchase of an animal. Each buyer must obtain a buyer number. Upon purchase, please inform the auctioneer that there are multiple buyers and have all buyer numbers available. Buyers pay the full bid price and they receive the animal. Animals may be taken home or sent to a processing facility. When checking out, please inform the clerk which processing facility will be used if the animal is designated for harvest.
- **BUY BACK PROGRAM** – This is for the buyers who would like to support the youth by purchasing an animal, but do not want to keep the animal. In this program the buyer will pay the difference between the purchase price and the buyback price. (For example – Buyer purchases 1200 lb. steer for \$3,500. Buy back price is \$1.10 per lb. 1200 lb. steer x 1.10 per lb. = \$1,320. \$3,500 - \$1,320 = \$2,180). Purchase price – (animal weight x buy back price) = amount buyer will pay to buy back.

- **ADD-ON PROGRAM** – This program allows individuals or businesses who wish to support the youth exhibiting livestock without the purchase of an animal. Add-ons are simply additional funds donated to specific individuals or groups of exhibitors. Supporters will need to check in and obtain a buyer number after obtaining a buyer's number, proceed to the clerk and inform them of which individuals or groups you would like to add on to and the amount. Add-ons can be done prior to and during the sale.

Four ways to buy:

1. **Attend the auction.** Make your own bids and enjoy the excitement of the auction. For 2021 you must have a number before bidding.
2. **Have an experienced buyer bid.** You can have an experience buyer bid for you while you are at the auction.
3. **Unable to attend.** If you are unable to attend the sale, but would like to buy an animal, contact Keefe Rice @ (307) 217-3680 or Shawn Miller @ (307) 217-3217 or a proxy buyer.
4. **Joint purchase.** If you would be interested in purchasing a half of a beef, swine or lamb; get together with another buyer or contact the Extension Office.

Local Processing Facilities:

Buyer will decide where they want their animal to be processed the night of the sale. Buyers will be asked their preferred processor or buy back as soon as the animal is sold. Kids will be in charge of getting that animal to the local processor of the buyer's choice.

If the buyer chooses to do the buy back program, that animal will be assigned to another buyer Sunday morning. The new buyer will then determine the preferred processor.
